3 Steps of implementation

1. problems of consultation (1 - 7)
2. RFE → 2 to 3 years (2014)
3. Episodes of care → 10 years (2020?)

- > 500'000 consultations
- > 100'000 patients
- > 1,5 Mio prescription lines

Monthly reports → running

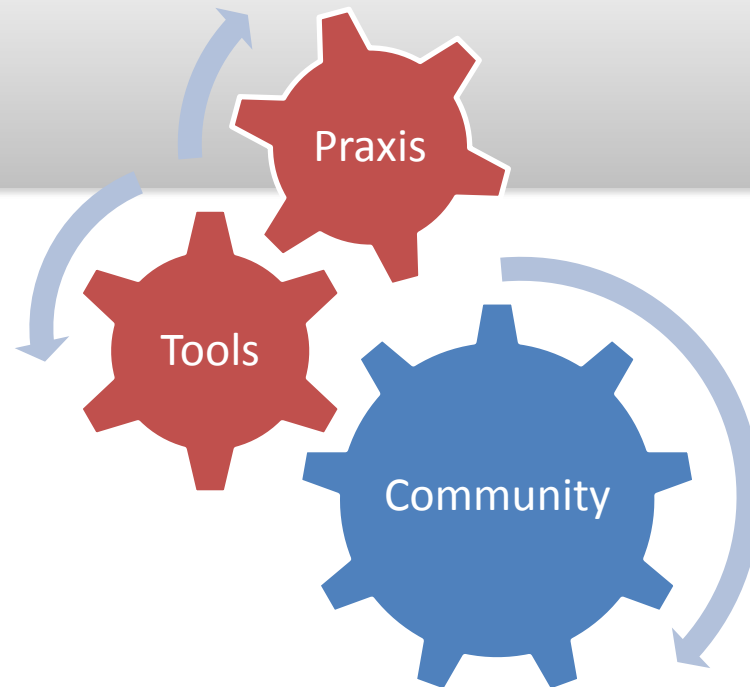
Publications → in progress
