 - Mortality, morbidity, primary care, clinical care, research, public health...
 - Consistency & interoperability across different uses

- 2. Serve as an international and multilingual reference standard**

 - Communication purposes

Definitions

- All ICD entities will have **definitions**:
 - key descriptions of the **meaning** of the category in human readable terms – to **guide users**
 - *Limited definition in Print Version – 100 words*
 - *Detailed definitions ONLINE*
- Definitions will be *compatible* with:
 - the **Content Model**
 - **Diagnostic Criteria**
 - across the **whole classification** and the versions

Definition of Disease

a set of dysfunction(s) in any of the body systems
including:

- with a known pattern of signs, symptoms & findings
 - » *symptomatology - manifestations*
- probably with an underlying explanatory mechanism
 - » *etiology*
- a distinct pattern of development over time
 - » *course and outcome*
- a known pattern of response to interventions
 - » *treatment response*
- with linkage to underlying genetic factors
 - » *genotypes, phenotypes and endophenotypes*
- with linkage to interacting environmental factors

ICD Revision Organizational Structure - now




Life-cycle of a Proposal





- The alpha draft has **not yet been approved** by the Topic Advisory Groups, Revision Steering Group or WHO




