The first column displays under the class code 1) status of the comment, 2) the kind of action, and 3) the alias for the person responsible for dealing with this specific comment.

Ad 1) the **status** can assume the values: 0=**submitted**, 1=**open**, 2=**closed**, 3=**follow-up**, 4=**suspend**, 5=**discuss**, 6=**withdrawn**, 7=**decision**.

Ad 2) The **kind** of action can be: **cmnt**=general comment, **chngclass**=change class, **delclass**=delete class, **addclass**=add class, **addsubclass**=add subclass, **chngrubric**=change rubric, **delrubric**=delete rubric, **addrubric**=add rubric.

The term **rubric** is used for all textual elements related to a class. The text directly related to *inclusion*, *exclusions*, *definitions*, *cross-reference* etc.

The blue background indicates a new **rubric** or **class**, the yellow background indicates the related **kind** of the new rubric or the **definition** for the new class. The red background used under *Nature* indicates that it is a **major** comment.

If participants have voted in **favour** or **disagreement** with a specific comment the votes will be displayed with a green background if there is more agreement than disagreement. An orange background if the overall vote is negative as in the lower example.

At every change of the *Response* the system generates a time stamp like: **|2|1|pz.20101026|**. The first number stands for the status of the comment, where the assnment is as described above. The second number points to the person to whom the task has been assigned at that specific date.
